

Whale Murals

The Whale Murals, located at the Livermore Water Reclamation Plant, were painted in 2010 by Darren Greenwood. It was unveiled on September 7, 2010 by the Livermore Commission for the Arts.

The whales were painted on the two digester tanks and the south and west walls of the Solids Handling Building. The whale murals were installed in addition to the existing marine life murals that were previously donated and painted on the north and east walls of the Solids Handling Building by the same artist. The Whale Murals provide a seamless continuation of the existing mural. It features full-height murals in each of the digester tanks highlighting additional humpback whales, as well as dolphins, grey whales, and other marine life.
