Penal Code 245 (a) (2) - Assault with a deadly weapon/gun

III. **FACTUAL INFORMATION:**

On May 23, 2010 at approximately 7:30 p.m., Livermore residents Michael Bartels, WMA, 24 years old and Brian D. Hawkey, WMA, 20 years old responded to the Livermore Police Department front lobby to report that they had been shot at by an acquaintance and Livermore resident Jacob A Quintal, WMA, 25 years old. Earlier that evening, Hawkey and Bartels drove to the 300 block of Junction Avenue to meet with Quintal. While Hawkey remained in the vehicle, Bartels contacted Quintal outside the vehicle where he and Quintal engaged in a verbal altercation about money. After the verbal exchange, Bartels got back into the vehicle via passenger side. As Hawkey began to drive away southbound on Junction Avenue, Quintal allegedly shot at the rear of the vehicle with a firearm and the round struck the rear spoiler of the vehicle near the rear window. Neither Hawkey nor Bartels sustained any visible injuries as a result of Quintal's alleged actions. Quintal was arrested and taken into custody.
