**III. FACTUAL INFORMATION:**

On March 29, 2010 at 4:26PM, the Livermore Police Department received a call from the Livermore Post Office located in the 200 block of South Livermore Avenue. The postal employee that called, stated two brown briefcases were found on the Northwest corner of the building next to the handicap ramp. While officers responded to the scene a second witness called the police department and stated he saw a light skinned Hispanic male (approximately 25 years old) with a black baseball cap place the briefcases at the Post Office. He then entered a white Saturn Vue driven by a white female with red hair (approximately 40 years old). Both drove away from the area.

The Post Office and surrounding businesses were evacuated and the Alameda County Bomb Squad responded. At 7:40 PM, the devices were detonated in place and found to be empty.

This is an-ongoing investigation with the assistance of the Postal Inspectors and the Alameda County Bomb Squad.

Several leads are currently being followed and pending the outcome of those leads, an updated press release may be released tomorrow, March 30, 2010.
