our operations were up nearly 24% to approximately 150,000 operations in the past twelve months. While this increase takes us to numbers we haven't seen in nearly ten years it still doesn't compare to our record operations in the 80's. Additional flight training as well as an overall increase in General Aviation traffic have substantially increased operations. I encourage all those interested in the latest updates in air traffic control to attend the Air Traffic Control Tower's safety meetings hosted in the Terminal by our Livermore Air Traffic Controllers.

**Rates & Charges Adjustment
Fiscal Year 2018-2019**

Section 11.08.040 of the City of Livermore Municipal Code requires the City Council to establish by resolution the rates and charges for the use of the facilities of the Livermore Municipal Airport. Resolution No. 2006-118, as amended by City Council and reflected in the May 22, 2006 meeting minutes, provided that Airport rates and charges would adjust annually, based on the increase in the Consumer Price Index ("CPI") for the preceding February-to-February period.
