- I. DATE AND TIME OF PRESS RELEASE: March 13, 2011 at 1700 hours
- II. TYPE OF INCIDENT/SITUATION/ANNOUNCEMENT: Possible Gang Related Shooting
- III. FACTUAL INFORMATION: On 03/13/2011 at approximately 1515 hours, the Livermore Police Department responded to the area of Chestnut Street at North I Street for a report of a subject suffering from a gunshot wound. When officers arrived they found two subjects suffering from gunshot wounds that appeared to have been from a shotgun. Several spent shotgun shells were found in the area of the shooting. The two victims were transported to a local trauma center to be treated for their injuries. Their injuries are not considered to be life threatening and both are in stable condition at this time. Information gathered at the scene was consistent with this crime being gang related. The Livermore Police Department is still investigating.
- IV. LOCATION OF INCIDENT: Chestnut Street at North I Street
- V. DATE & TIME OCCURRED: March 13, 2011 at approximately 1515 hours.
- VI. SUBJECTS ARRESTED/INVOLVED IN INVESTIGATION: The victims names are being withheld at this time. One victim is a juvenile and one victim is an adult.

There were at least two suspects involved in this incident.

Suspect #1: White male, wearing red clothing.

Suspect #2: Unknown male wearing a ski-mask and red clothing.
