



- I. DATE AND TIME OF PRESS RELEASE: May 28, 2011, 2100 hrs
- II. TYPE OF INCIDENT/SITUATION/ANNOUNCEMENT: Fatal Motorcycle Collision
- III. FACTUAL INFORMATION:

On 05-28-11, approx. 1239 hrs, the Livermore Police Department responded to a single vehicle collision on National Drive near Longfellow Court. This is a commercial industrial area of Livermore with relatively light traffic. A Yamaha sportbike being ridden by a 25 year old Hayward resident had left the roadway and struck a tree. The rider suffered critical injuries and was airlifted to Eden Hospital Trauma Center in Castro Valley.

The rider was pronounced dead at Eden Trauma Center after extensive efforts to save his life. The identity of the rider is being withheld until the Alameda County Sheriff's Coroner's Office can notify next of kin.

Witnesses described the motorcycle as traveling in excess of 80 MPH just prior to the crash. National Drive is a posted 40 MPH roadway. The motorcyclist was wearing a helmet, and is not currently licensed to ride a motorcycle. The collision investigation is ongoing, and anyone who witnessed the collision is asked to contact the Livermore Police Traffic Unit at 925-371-4850. National Drive was closed until approximately 1645 hrs. due to the investigation.
