

The City of Livermore (City) is holding a community workshop to get input on the Livermore Climate Action Plan (CAP) currently being developed. The CAP will contain objectives, measures, and strategies the City, private and public organizations, and the community can take to reduce greenhouse gas emissions (GHGs) related to:

- · Utilizing clean, renewable energy
- Making smarter transportation choices
- Increasing water conservation
- Recycling and reusing

The goal of the CAP is to outline activities that will reduce GHG emission levels to 15 percent below 2008 conditions by 2020. This is the reduction goal adopted in the Climate Change Element of the General Plan. Implementation of the CAP will also support the statewide effort to reduce emissions in California to 1990 levels by 2020 under Assembly Bill 32.
