- II. ANNOUNCEMENT: **\*\*UPDATE\*\*** Police Activity on Gerrilyn Way
- III. FACTUAL INFORMATION:

On February 16, 2012, approximately 3:38 p.m., officers from the Livermore Police Department responded to the 4600 block of Gerrilyn Way (La Vina Apartment complex) for a suspicious occurrence. Upon arrival, officers established contact with the reporting party who told them the subject threatened to harm himself, and made threats toward responding officers. LPD Officers established a perimeter and attempted contact with the subject who refused to communicate with them. Various means of contact were attempted, including amplified voice announcements from a police vehicle. No contact was made and no crimes were committed by the subject.

### **UPDATED INFORMATION:**

While conducting the follow-up investigation, the subject was located today around 8:30 am in the area of Mines Road and Dana Circle, Livermore. The subject was transported to the hospital for a medical and mental health evaluation.

Officers located a letter written by the subject, in which he apologized for his actions. The letter indicated the subject had intended to commit "suicide by cop."
