On January 16, 2013 the Livermore Police Department's Investigations Bureau identified 24 year old Jacob Kober as the suspect in the shooting death of Robert Ogden.

After the December 29, 2012 Springtown shooting, Kober fled to the state of Oregon. Kober was arrested in the city of Springfield Oregon. Kober is currently in the custody of the Lane County Sheriff's Department awaiting extradition.

- III. **FACTUAL INFORMATION**

On Saturday, December 29, 2012 at approximately 07:21 am, a male resident on Galaxy Ct. in Livermore saw a male subject lying down in the grassland to the rear of his residence. This area borders the Springtown Golf Course fairway and neighboring bicycle paths. The male resident saw a female jogger near the down subject. The female jogger screamed to the resident that the subject was unresponsive and to call 911.

Livermore officers arrived on scene and found that the down subject was pulseless and not breathing. The Livermore Pleasanton Fire Department confirmed the subject was deceased.

The Livermore Police Department Criminal Investigations Bureau responded and took over the investigation.

The decedent was identified as Kenneth Robert Ogden a 28 year old male resident from Livermore. It appeared that Ogden had suffered from multiple gunshot wounds. Although the official cause of death is still pending the autopsy and report of the Alameda County Coroner's Office.

There is no indication that this is gang related and due to the sensitive nature of this investigation, detectives do not wish to release finite details as to ensure a successful future prosecution. We understand the public may have questions in regards to this case and want to ensure you that we will update this press release and provide further information as soon as it is reasonably prudent.
