III. **FACTUAL INFORMATION:**

On February 16, 2013, the Livermore Police Department began an investigation into threats made via the internet to one of the victims in the Christine Hubbs criminal case from 2010. Threats came shortly after Christine Hubbs was re-arrested on February 15, 2013 after being released from prison on February 10, 2013.

UPDATED INFORMATION:

On February 27, 2013, Livermore Police Department Detectives concluded their investigation and as a result arrested 3 juvenile minors, whose names are being withheld due to their age, a violation of Section 653.2 of the Penal Code – Threats over the Internet.

LPD Detectives did not locate any evidence that would suggest Christine Hubbs initiated or encouraged others to make threats on her behalf to either victim from her original criminal case.
