

- I. **DATE OF PRESS RELEASE:** March 27, 2014
- II. **TYPE OF INCIDENT:** Robbery (211 PC – Robbery)
- III. **FACTUAL INFORMATION:**

The Livermore Police Department is investigating a robbery that occurred at the ATM machine at the Bank of America located at 4213 First Street. On March 26, 2014, at about 10:00 p.m., a white male suspect approached a female who was standing at the ATM machine. The suspect was armed with a baseball bat. The suspected demanded that the victim give him all of her money. The suspect stole the victim's cell phone during the robbery. The victim ran away from the suspect, entered a nearby business, and called 911. The suspect then got into a red sedan vehicle and left the area. The victim in this case was uninjured.

The suspect was described as a white male, approximately 30 years old, and between 5'03" and 5'05". The suspect was last seen wearing a black baseball cap and a black hooded sweatshirt. The suspect was in possession of a baseball bat during the robbery.

LPD officers were able to obtain two images from the surveillance video system. One image is the suspect approaching from his vehicle walking toward the victim and the second image is of the suspect robbing the victim at the ATM machine.

The Livermore Police Department is seeking the community's assistance in locating and identifying the suspect in this case. If anyone has information or recognizes the suspect from the surveillance still photo, they are encouraged to call the Livermore Police Department at (925) 294-7531.
