



BIO – Vice Mayor Bob Woerner

Bob is a 44-year resident of Livermore and was appointed to the City Council in January of 2012 and was elected in 2014 and 2018. He is currently serving his third term as Vice Mayor and co-chairs the City's Working Group on Equity and Inclusion. Prior to serving on the Council, Bob was on the Planning Commission.

Bob has two adult sons, Phil and Steve, who were both educated in the Livermore School System and had the benefit of the great quality of life offered by the City as they grew up. Bob is married to Nova Starling, a local artist and President of AARTII.org, an educational nonprofit.
